AN ORDINANCE to amend "The Railway Servants Ordinance, 1894." (33—1894.)

BE it enacted by the Governor of Trinidad and Tobago with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof as follows:—

1. This Ordinance may for all purposes be cited as Short title.  
"The Railway Servants (amendment) Ordinance, 1895."

This Ordinance shall be read and construed as one Construction.  
with "The Railway Servants Ordinance, 1894," hereinafter called the Principal Ordinance.

2. No fine imposed under the authority of Section Fines under Principal Ordinance.  
3. of the Principal Ordinance by the General Manager upon any person in the service of the Railway shall exceed one month's pay of the person so fined.
