AN ORDINANCE to amend “The Offences Amendment Ordinance, 1894” (1-1894).

BE it enacted by the Governor of Trinidad and Tobago with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof as follows:—

1. The words “and not less than four years” at the end of the first paragraph of the fifth Section of “The Offences Amendment Ordinance, 1894” (1-1894), are hereby repealed.
