AN ORDINANCE to amend "The Newspaper Ordinance, 1894."—(35—1894.)

BE it enacted by the Governor of Trinidad and Tobago with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof as follows :—

1. This Ordinance may for all purposes be cited as Short title.
"The Newspaper (amendment) Ordinance, 1895."

This Ordinance shall be read and construed as one Construction.
with "The Newspaper Ordinance, 1894," hereinafter called the Principal Ordinance.

The Principal Ordinance and this Ordinance may together be cited as "The Newspaper Ordinances, 1894 and 1895."

Proviso to Sec.
8 of Principal
Ordinance.

2. In Section 8 of the Principal Ordinance after the words "for whom such surety shall have become bound," shall be read the following :—

Provided always that notwithstanding any such discharge such Surety shall continue to be liable in respect of all penalties incurred by and all damages and costs adjudged against any such Printer, Publisher, or Proprietor before the date of such discharge.
