REGULATIONS

MADE BY THE MINISTER UNDER SECTION 24 OF THE  
CONSERVATION OF WILD LIFE ACT

THE CONSERVATION OF WILD LIFE (AMENDMENT)  
REGULATIONS, 1989

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Conservation of Wild Life (Amendment) Regulations, 1989. Citation

2. The Conservation of Wild Life (Amendment) Regulations, 1987 are hereby revoked. Regulations

3. The Second Schedule to the Conservation of Wild Life Act is amended— Second Schedule to Act  
amended  
Chap. 67:01  
(a) by deleting therefrom, for the period 1st October to 31st October, 1989, the birds listed in Part II;  
(b) by deleting therefrom, for the period 1st March to 31st March, 1990, the animals listed in Parts I, II and III.

4. The Conservation of Wild Life Regulations are amended— Regulations  
amended  
(a) in regulation 2, by renumbering regulation 2 as 2(1) and inserting the following new subregulations—

“ (2) Where a licence issued under section 6 of the Act expires and is returned to a Game Warden, a new licence may be issued by the Game Warden.

(3) The Game Wardens shall issue a separate State Game Licence, each of a different colour, in respect of each of the following animals, up to a maximum of three State Game Licences to each hunter—

Alligator or Cayman/Lizards

Agouti

Armadillo (Tattoo)

Deer

Lappe

Quenk (Peccary or Wild Hog)

Waterfowl, that is to say, the birds listed in Part II of the Schedule to the Act

Cage Birds, that is to say, the birds listed in Part III of the Second Schedule to the Act.”;

- (b) in regulation 3, by deleting the words "five dollars" and substituting therefor the words "twenty dollars";
- (c) by inserting immediately after regulation 4, the following new regulations—

"Restriction  
on hunting

4A. (1) No person shall hunt in the Western Northern Range except during the period from October 1st to December 31st of each year.

(2) In these Regulations, "the Western Northern Range" means the area bounded on the North by the Caribbean Sea, on the East by the Arima/Blanchisseuse Road, on the South by the Eastern Main Road and the Western Main Road and on the West by the Gulf of Paria.

Firearms  
prohibited

4B No person shall use any firearm for purposes of hunting during the month of October, 1989.";

- (d) by deleting the First Schedule and substituting therefor the following—

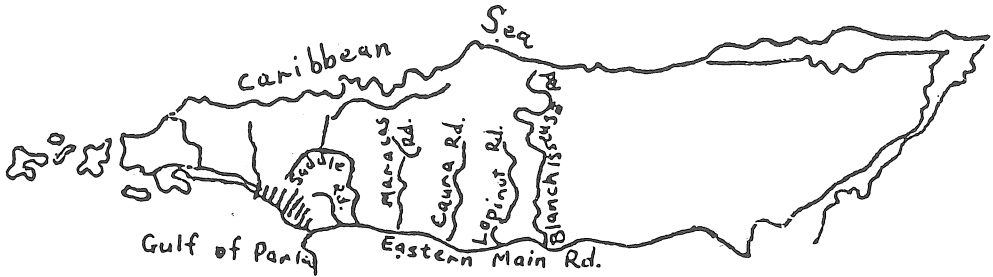

## CONDITIONS

1. Period of Open Season is the period of the year not specified in the Fifth Schedule to the Act.
2. Mandatory return data form must be returned to the Forestry Division on expiry of licence in order to obtain a new state game licence.
3. Hunting with guns is prohibited for the months of .....
4. Hunting in the Western Northern Range is restricted to 1st October to 31st December. Boundaries are—North by the Caribbean Sea, East by the Arima/Blanchisseuse Road, South by the Eastern Main Road and the Western Main Road and West by the Gulf of Paria (See map below).



5. Failure to comply with any of the above conditions will lead to cancellation of the state game licence and prosecution under the Conservation of Wild Life Act."
