AN ORDINANCE to authorize the raising of a further sum of £100,000 for Railway Extension and Public Works.

WHEREAS by "The Railway Extension and Public Works Loan Ordinance, 1894" (20—1894) the Governor was authorized at such times and by such instalments as might be deemed expedient to borrow a sum not exceeding £400,000 by the sale of Inscribed Stock under the provisions of "The General Loan and Inscribed Stock Ordinance, 1890" (28—1890) to be applied exclusively to the several public works in the said Ordinance mentioned;

And whereas it is expedient to authorize the Governor to borrow a further sum not exceeding £100,000 to be applied exclusively to the several public

works mentioned in the said Railway Extension and Public Works Loan Ordinance, 1894: Be it enacted by the Governor of Trinidad and Tobago with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof as follows:—

Short title. 1. This Ordinance may be cited as “The Railway Extension and Public Works Loan Ordinance, 1895.”

It shall be read as one with “The Railway Extension and Public Works Loan Ordinance, 1894” hereinafter called the principal Ordinance.

This Ordinance and the principal Ordinance may together be cited as “The Railway Extension and Public Works Loan Ordinances, 1894-5.”

Power to raise Loan. 2. It shall be lawful for the Governor at such times and by such instalments as may be deemed expedient to borrow a further sum not exceeding £100,000 by the sale of Inscribed Stock under the provisions of “The General Loan and Inscribed Stock Ordinance, 1890” to be applied exclusively to the several public works in the principal Ordinance mentioned.

Passed in Council this Second day of September, in the year of Our Lord one thousand eight hundred and ninety-five.
