AN ORDINANCE to facilitate the registration of certain documents.

**B**E it enacted by the Governor of Trinidad and Tobago with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof as follows :—

1. Notwithstanding anything to the contrary contained in "The Execution and Registration of Deeds Ordinance, 1884" (18 of 1884) or in any other Ordinance or law, the Registrar-General, or in Tobago the Deputy Registrar, shall register all deeds, grants, transfers, or conveyances whatever purporting to be made or executed under the provisions of the Casual Revenue Appropriation Ordinance, 1894 whenever such deeds, grants, transfers, or conveyances respectively shall be tendered to him for registration by the Sub-Intendant of Crown Lands.

2. It shall not be necessary for the validity of any such deed, grant, transfer, or conveyance that the same should be executed and attested according to the provisions of the said Ordinance No. 18 of 1884.
