amended | 3. Regulation 2(2) of the Regulations is amended by deleting the word “four” and substituting the word “six”. |

revoked | 4. Regulations 4A and 4B of the Regulations are revoked. |

substituted | 5. Regulation 5 of the Regulations is revoked and the following regulation substituted: <p style="margin-left: 40px;">“Prohibition

lights</p> <p style="margin-left: 40px;">5. (1) No person shall use an artificial light for the purpose of hunting.</p> <p style="margin-left: 40px;">(2) A person who contravenes subregulation (1) commits an offence and is liable on summary conviction to a fine of two hundred dollars.”.</p> |
| Regulation 6
amended | 6. Regulation 6 of the Regulations is amended by revoking subregulation (1) and substituting the following subregulation: <p style="margin-left: 40px;">“ (1) No person shall have in his possession, serve, purchase, sell or expose for sale—</p> <p style="margin-left: 80px;">(a) during the close season, any animal referred to in Parts I and II; or</p> <p style="margin-left: 80px;">(b) from 1st October to 31st October annually, any animal referred to in Part II,</p> <p style="margin-left: 40px;">of the Second Schedule to the Act.”.</p> |

7. The First Schedule to the Regulations is amended by—
- (a) deleting the words “on expiry of licence” wherever they occur and substituting the words “on or before 31st March annually”; and
- (b) deleting clause 4.
