AN ORDINANCE to amend the Corporal Punishment Ordinance, No. 107.

BE it enacted by the Governor of Trinidad and Tobago with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof as follows:—

Short Title.

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Corporal Punishment (Amendment) Ordinance, 1914.

Corporal Punishment not to be inflicted on female,
Repeal.

2. No sentence of flogging or whipping shall be passed upon any female.

3. Sub-section (3) of Section 4 of the Corporal Punishment Ordinance (No. 107) is hereby repealed.

Amendment of Section 7 of Ordinance 107.

4. In line 2 of Section 7 of the Corporal Punishment Ordinance (No. 107) in lieu of "14" shall be read "16."

Passed in Council this Fourth day of March, in the year of Our Lord one thousand nine hundred and fourteen.
