AN ORDINANCE to amend the Government Currency Notes Ordinance, No. 244.

BE it enacted by the Governor of Trinidad and Tobago with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof as follows:—

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Government Short Title. Currency Notes (Amendment) Ordinance, 1914.

2. Sub-section (6) of Section 10 of Ordinance No. 244, Amendment of Section 10 (6) of Ordinance 244. is amended by striking out the words "a Secretary of State" in the third line and inserting in lieu thereof the words "the Governor."

Passed in Council this thirtieth day of October, in the year of Our Lord one thousand nine hundred and fourteen.
