AN ORDINANCE to amend the British and Colonial Probate Ordinance, No. 100.

BE it enacted by the Governor of Trinidad and Tobago with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof as follows:—

Short Title 1. This Ordinance may be cited as the British and Colonial Probate (Amending) Ordinance, 1915.

Amendment of Section 2 of Ordinance 100. 2. Section 2 of the British and Colonial Probate Ordinance, No. 100, is amended by striking out the words "and in Scotland means the Sheriff Court of the County of Edinburgh" in the fourth and fifth lines thereof.

Passed in Council this Twenty-eighth day of May, in the year of Our Lord one thousand nine hundred and fifteen.
