AN ORDINANCE to amend the Land Charges and Land Taxes Ordinance, No. 204.

BE it enacted by the Governor of Trinidad and Tobago with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof as follows:—

1.—(1.) This Ordinance may be cited as the Land Charges Short Title. and Land Taxes (Amendment) Ordinance, 1915.

(2.) The Land Charges and Land Taxes Ordinance (No. 204) is hereinafter referred to as the Principal Ordinance.

2.—(1.) In addition to the return required by Section 31 Sub-return of houses. of the Principal Ordinance, the owner of any land within any Ward shall make a sub-return on or before the Thirty-first day of October in each year according to such form as may from time to time be prescribed by the Governor, specifying the name of the occupier, if any, of such land or any part thereof and of the owner or occupier of every house on such land and the annual value of every such house.

(2.) Such sub-return shall be filed in the Warden's office and shall for the purposes of voting at elections for a Local Road Board as provided for in Sections 47 and 48 of the Roads Ordinance (No. 200) be deemed to be and form part of the assessment roll of the particular Ward in which the land or house in respect of which the sub-return is made is situated.

3. The provisions of Section 32 of the Principal Ordinance as to the person by whom and as to the time the return therein referred to is required to be made, and the provisions of Section 33 of the said Ordinance shall apply to a sub-return as required in Section 2 of this Ordinance.

Amendment of
Section 6 of
Ordinance 204.

4. Section 6 of the Principal Ordinance is amended by striking out the words "and whether or not the Sub-Intendant has exercised the powers vested in him by Section 11" in lines seven and eight.

Saving.

5. Nothing in this Ordinance contained shall affect the liability imposed upon the owner of land to pay land charges under the provisions of the Principal Ordinance.
