AN ORDINANCE to provide for the discipline of members of the Local Forces serving with His Majesty's Regular Forces, and for other purposes incidental thereto.

BE it enacted by the Governor of Trinidad and Tobago with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof as follows:—

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Local Forces Short Title. (Foreign Service) Ordinance, 1915, and shall be read as one with the Local Forces Ordinances.

2. In this Ordinance the term "His Majesty's Regular Interpreta-
tion. Forces" has the same meaning as in the Army Act.

3. Members of the Local Forces—

(a.) voluntarily serving with His Majesty's Regular Forces outside the Colony; or

(b.) on their way from the Colony for the purpose of so serving; or

(c.) on their way back to the Colony after so serving; shall be subject to the Army Act as if they were part of His Majesty's Regular Forces.

Passed in Council this Thirteenth day of September, in the year of Our Lord one thousand nine hundred and fifteen.
