AN ORDINANCE to enable fees to be charged in respect of Certificates of Naturalization granted in the Colony under the provisions of the British Nationality and Status of Aliens Act, 1914.

WHEREAS provision is made under the British Nationality and Status of Aliens Act, 1914 of the Imperial Parliament for the issuing in the Colony of Certificates of Naturalization under that Act;

And whereas it is expedient to provide for the payment of fees in respect of the grant of such Certificates of Naturalization as aforesaid;

Be it enacted by the Governor of Trinidad and Tobago with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof as follows:—

Short Title. 1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Imperial Naturalization (Fees) Ordinance, 1915.

Regulations as to fees. 2.—(1.) The Governor in Executive Council may as regards the grant in the Colony of Certificates of Naturalization under the provisions of the British Nationality and

Status of Aliens Act, 1914, make regulations providing for the imposition of fees in respect of :—

- (a.) Any registration authorised to be made under the said Act or any regulations made thereunder;
- (b.) The making of any declaration or the grant of any certificate authorised to be made or granted by the said Act or regulations ;
- (c.) The administration or registration of any oath required by the said Act or regulations.

(2.) All regulations made by the Governor in Executive Council under the preceding sub-section shall be published in the *Royal Gazette*.

Passed in Council this Ninth day of August, in the year of Our Lord one thousand nine hundred and fifteen.
