AN ORDINANCE to provide for the payment of a proportion of the pensions payable, on their final retirement from the public service, to certain officers in the service of the Government of the Colony by the Corporation of the City of Port-of-Spain.

[13th March, 1916.]

WHEREAS the officers named in the Schedule to this Ordinance were, upon the transfer of the Waterworks and of the Sewerage Works of the City of Port-of-Spain to the Water Authority and Sewerage Board, seconded for service under such Authority and Board ;

And whereas on the said Waterworks and Sewerage Works becoming subsequently vested in the Town Board of Port-of-Spain as the successors of the said Water Authority and Sewerage Board, the service of one of the said officers was continued under the said Town Board ;

And whereas under and by virtue of the Port-of-Spain Corporation Ordinances, the said Town Board was dissolved and all duties, powers, authorities, interests, rights, privileges and property of all preceding Port-of-Spain Corpora-

tions were transferred to and vested in the Mayor, Aldermen and Citizens of the City of Port-of-Spain (hereinafter referred to as the Corporation) ;

And whereas the Corporation has agreed that it is just and expedient to make provision for the payment by the Corporation of a portion of the pensions respectively payable to such officers proportionate to the period during which they were seconded for service as aforesaid ;

Be it enacted by the Governor of Trinidad and Tobago with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof as follows :—

1. It is hereby agreed and enacted that the Corporation shall pay to the Receiver-General of the Colony such proportion of the pension payable by the Colonial Government to each of the officers named in the first column of the Schedule to this Ordinance, if and when the same shall become due, as the period mentioned in the second column of the said Schedule bears to the whole period in respect of which a pension is payable to each of them by the Colonial Government.

2.—(1) The Corporation shall make the payments required under Section 1 of this Ordinance on the thirty-first day of March, the thirtieth day of June, the thirtieth day of September and the thirty-first day of December in every year so long as all or any of the pensions therein mentioned are payable.

(2.) In the event of only a portion of any such pension being payable in respect of any particular year, the Corporation shall be required only to pay such portion.
