**B**E it enacted by the Governor of Trinidad and Tobago with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof as follows:—

- Short Title.      1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Board of Agriculture Ordinance 1909.
- Repeal.            2. Sub-section (2) of Section 4 of the Ordinance No. 35-1908 is hereby repealed, and in lieu thereof shall be read the following:—
- Duties of Board.      (2.) The Board shall from time to time advise as to the distribution of the business of the Department of Agriculture among the several persons employed therein as the Board may think right, and these officers shall perform such duties in relation to that business as the Governor on the recommendation of the Board may in his discretion direct.
