AN ORDINANCE to amend the Apportionment Ordinance No. 77.

BE it enacted by the Governor of Trinidad and Tobago with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof as follows:—

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Apportionment Short title. Ordinance 1909.

2. Section 6 of the Apportionment Ordinance No. 77 is Repeal. hereby repealed, and in lieu thereof shall be read the following:—

6. When any lands not theretofore subject to land Crown grants. charges or land taxes shall have been granted by His Majesty to any person, such person shall be deemed liable to pay in respect of his ownership during the remainder of the current period in respect of which such land taxes or land charges are leviable, an apportioned part of all land taxes and charges or other charges or

annual payments collectible in respect of such land, which shall become due and payable when the annual land tax or charge for the year following that in which the grant is issued shall be payable, and shall be recoverable therewith in the same manner as a land tax or land charge under the provisions of the Land Charges and Land Taxes Ordinance No. 204.

Saving.

3. The repeal by this Ordinance enacted shall not affect the validity or invalidity of anything done or suffered or any right accrued or liability incurred before or any proceeding pending or uncompleted at the commencement hereof.

Passed in Council this sixth day of December, in the year of Our Lord one thousand nine hundred and nine.
