AN ORDINANCE to amend the Customs Ordinance No. 178.

BE it enacted by the Governor of Trinidad and Tobago with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof as follows :—

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Customs Ordinance 1909. It shall be read with the Customs Ordinance No. 178 and the Ordinance No. 7—1906. Short title.

2. Section 13 of the Customs Ordinance No. 178 is hereby repealed, and in lieu thereof shall be read the following :— Repeal.

13. It shall be lawful for the Governor from time to time by proclamation to prohibit the importation of arms, ammunition or gunpowder, or of any goods or merchandize of any description whatsoever. Power to prohibit importation.

Any such proclamation may prohibit importation until the revocation thereof or during such period as may be specified therein.
