BE it enacted by the Governor of Trinidad and Tobago with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof as follows:—

Short title.

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Attachment of Debts Ordinance 1909.

No order for attachment in certain cases.

2. No order for the attachment of

(a.) any money payable to any contractor or other person in respect of work done for the Government or any Department thereof;

(b.) the wages of any servant, labourer or workman shall be made by any Court of civil jurisdiction in this Colony.

Passed in Council this sixth day of December, in the year of Our Lord one thousand nine hundred and nine.
