AN ORDINANCE relating to Land Charges in Tobago.

BE it enacted by the Governor of Trinidad and Tobago with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof as follows:—

Short title.

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Tobago Land Charges Ordinance, 1911. It shall be read as one with the Ordinance No. 204.

Indemnity clause.

2. All taxes on lands and houses raised, levied, collected and paid in the Ward of Tobago on and from the first day of January 1899 to the commencement hereof shall be deemed to have been legally and properly raised, levied, collected and paid, and the acts of all persons in the *bona fide* discharge of their duties in the raising, levying, collecting and paying of such land and house tax are hereby declared to have been good, valid and effectual to all intents and purposes.

Collection of unpaid tax.

3. From the commencement of this Ordinance it shall be lawful for the Warden of Tobago and all persons acting under his authority to do all acts and things whatsoever necessary

for the raising, levying, collecting and paying of the land and house tax in the said Ward remaining unpaid at the commencement hereof.

4. On all lands and houses in the Ward of Tobago not exempted under Ordinance No. 205, there shall for the year 1911 be raised, levied, collected and paid unto His Majesty, His Heirs and Successors for the use of the Colony the following taxes, that is to say on every acre of land an annual tax of one shilling; on every house the rent or annual value of which does not exceed two pounds ten shillings, an annual tax of two shillings and six pence; and on every house the rent or annual value of which exceeds two pounds ten shillings an annual tax at the rate of seven pounds ten shillings for every one hundred pounds of such rent or value. Taxes for 1911.

5. On and after the first day of January, 1912 the tax on lands and houses imposed by the Land Charges and Land Taxes Ordinance No. 204 shall be raised, levied, collected and paid unto His Majesty His Heirs and Successors for the use of the Colony on all lands and houses in the Ward of Tobago not exempted under Ordinance No. 205, and all the provisions of the said Ordinance No. 204 shall extend to and be in force in the said Ward. Taxes for 1912.
