AN ORDINANCE to amend the Shop Assistants (Hours) Ordinance, 1910. (13-1910.)

BE it enacted by the Governor of Trinidad and Tobago with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof as follows:—

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Shop Hours Short title. Ordinance, 1911.

2. In any order under Section 6 of the Ordinance No. 13-1910, it shall be lawful for the Governor in Executive Council to vary the hours of work mentioned in Section 2 of the said Ordinance; and the Governor may in any such order substitute for Saturday as therein mentioned any other day as a day on which shorter hours shall be worked than on ordinary days. Governor may vary hours.

Passed in Council this twenty-second day of May, in the year of Our Lord one thousand nine hundred and eleven.
