BE it enacted by the Governor of Trinidad and Tobago with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof as follows:—

Short title.

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Industrial Training (Amendment) Ordinance, 1911, and shall be read as one with an Ordinance entitled "An Ordinance to provide for the promotion of Industrial Training" (No. 5-1911), which is hereinafter referred to as the principal Ordinance.

Short title of Ordinance 5-1911.

2. Section 1 of the principal Ordinance is hereby repealed, and in lieu thereof shall be read the following:—

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Industrial Training Ordinance, 1911.

Application of Section 11 of Ordinance 5-1911.

3. The following words shall be inserted after the word "Ordinance" in the second line of Section 11 of the principal Ordinance:—

"or other than an artizan engaged, prior to the commencement of this Ordinance, in any trade hereinafter referred to."
