AN ORDINANCE to amend the Public Health (Special Powers) Ordinance, No. 188.

**B**E it enacted by the Governor of Trinidad and Tobago with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof as follows:—

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Public Health Short title. (Special Powers) Amendment Ordinance, 1911, and shall be read as one with the Public Health (Special Powers) Ordinance, No. 188, which is hereinafter referred to as the principal Ordinance.

2. Section 3 of the principal Ordinance is amended in the following respects:— Amendment of Section 3 of No. 188.

- (1.) By inserting after the word "suffering" in the second line of sub-section (1) *a.* the words "or likely from exposure to infection to suffer."

(2.) By striking out sub-section (1) *b.* and inserting in lieu thereof:—

*b.* To order the isolation, removal, disinfection and destruction of

(i.) personal effects and goods; or

(ii.) houses, stores, warehouses or buildings, either singly or within such areas as may be specified in the order; or

(iii.) any other property;

exposed to infection from cholera, yellow fever, small-pox or any other infectious disease, subject to such compensation as the Governor, with the consent of the Legislative Council, may think fit to order.

3. The power to make regulations conferred upon the Governor in Executive Council by Section 8 of the Principal Ordinance and to attach penalties by way of fine or imprisonment for any breach thereof as therein mentioned is hereby declared to extend to regulations made by the Governor in Executive Council for enforcing, or preventing the obstruction of, any orders made under Section 3 of the Principal Ordinance as amended by this Ordinance.

Passed in Council this Fourth day of December, in the year of Our Lord one thousand nine hundred and eleven.
