AN ORDINANCE to amend the Sale of Produce Ordinance, 1909.

BE it enacted by the Governor of Trinidad and Tobago with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof as follows:—

Short Title.

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Sale of Produce (Amendment) Ordinance, 1912, and shall be read as one with the Sale of Produce Ordinance, 1909.

Amendment
of Section 30
of No. 8 of
1909.

2. Section 30 of the Sale of Produce Ordinance, 1909, is amended by inserting at the end of line 7 thereof the words "and whether he is the owner, tenant or contractor in occupation of any such lands, or the servant or agent of any such owner, tenant or contractor."
