AN ORDINANCE to amend the Estate Duty Ordinances
1908 and 1909.

BE it enacted by the Governor of Trinidad and Tobago with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof as follows:—

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Estate Duty Ordinance (Amendment) Ordinance, 1912, and shall be read as one with the Estate Duty Ordinances, 1908 and 1909. Short Title.

2. Where money has been deposited in the Colonial Treasury in the manner described in Section 32 of the Royal Order in Council relating to Legacy and Succession Duty dated 3rd February 1851; it shall be lawful for the Governor in Executive Council, on being satisfied that it is to the advantage of any infant interested in money deposited under such section that such money or any part thereof should be deposited in the Government Savings Bank, to order that such money or part thereof be so deposited in the name of Deposit of infants' money under Section 32 of Legacy Duty Order.

the Administrator-General as trustee for such infant, and that any interest received by the Administrator-General be also deposited from time to time in the said Savings Bank and added to the amount of the sum originally deposited.

Ord. 12-1905. 3. The provisions of the Savings Banks Ordinance, 1905 shall not apply to deposits made under this Ordinance.
