AN ORDINANCE to amend the Roads Ordinance, No. 200.

**B**E it enacted by the Governor of Trinidad and Tobago with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof as follows:—

Short Title.

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Roads (Amendment) Ordinance, 1912, and shall be read as one with the Roads Ordinance, No. 200, which is hereinafter referred to as the Principal Ordinance.

Sec. 4 of Ord.

2. Section 4 of the Principal Ordinance is amended:—

(1.) By inserting after clause (*h*) the following as clause (*h*<sup>1</sup>):—

Level  
crossings.

(*h*<sup>1</sup>.) For securing the safety of the public in the use of public roads crossed by any railway or tramway on the level, and for directing the doing of any work or taking of any precautions necessary to effect that purpose.

(2.) By adding at the end of clause (i) the words Declaring  
main roads to  
be local roads.  
“and how and under what conditions main roads may  
“be changed into local roads.”

twelve.
