AN ORDINANCE to amend the Balata Gum Ordinance 1905, (37—1905).

BE it enacted by the Governor of Trinidad and Tobago with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof as follows:—

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Balata Gum Short title. Ordinance 1906. It shall be read as one with the Balata Gum Ordinance 1905, hereinafter called the principal Construction. Ordinance. The principal Ordinance and this Ordinance may be cited together as the Balata Gum Ordinances 1905-6.

2. Section 2 of the principal Ordinance is hereby repealed. Repeal.

3. Section 4 of the principal Ordinance is hereby repealed, Repeal. and in lieu thereof shall be read the following:—

4. Any person contravening the provisions of Section 3 hereof shall be guilty of an offence, and shall be liable on conviction to a penalty not exceeding fifty pounds, and in default of payment to imprisonment with or without hard labour for any term not exceeding three months. Penalty for conveying without permit.

4. This Ordinance shall commence on the day appointed for the commencement of the principal Ordinance under Section 13 thereof.
