AN ORDINANCE to amend the Customs Ordinance
No. 178.

BE it enacted by the Governor of Trinidad and Tobago with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof as follows :—

1. This Ordinance shall be read as one with the Customs Ordinance No. 178.

2. In Section 20 of the Customs Ordinance No. 178 in line 3 after the words “harbour of San Fernando” shall be read the words “or in the harbour of Scarborough or in any other harbour in the Colony to be approved by the Governor.”

Passed in Council this Ninth day of April, in the year of Our Lord one thousand nine hundred and six.
