AN ORDINANCE to amend the Yaws Ordinance, No. 191.

**B**E it enacted by the Governor of Trinidad and Tobago with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof as follows:—

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Yaws Ordinance 1906. It shall be read as one with the Yaws Ordinance No. 191. The said Ordinance and this Ordinance may together be cited as the Yaws Ordinances. Short title.  
Construction.

2. Any person who, while under medical treatment for Yaws, leaves any hospital or ward of any hospital without the permission of the Medical Officer in charge of such hospital or ward, shall be guilty of an offence against the Yaws Ordinances. Leaving

The provisions of this section shall be in addition to and not in derogation of, those of Section 10 of the Yaws Ordinance, No. 191.

3. It shall be lawful for the Governor by proclamation to set apart any portion of a prison, or of a hospital or ward established under Section 2 of the Yaws Ordinance No. 191, as a Prison for

place in which persons suffering from yaws and sentenced to imprisonment under Section 4 hereof shall be detained, and it shall be lawful for the Governor in Executive Council from time to time to make, alter and revoke rules and regulations, as to the management of such portions so set apart and as to the treatment and discipline of persons so detained.

4. When any person suffering from yaws is sentenced to imprisonment for any offence, or for the non-payment of any money or penalty, the Judge or Justice inflicting the imprisonment, shall make order that such person shall be committed to undergo such imprisonment to a place set apart by proclamation under the last preceding section hereof.
