AN ORDINANCE to amend the Bakehouses Ordinance 1905.

BE it enacted by the Governor of Trinidad and Tobago with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof as follows:—

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Bakehouses Short title. (Amendment) Ordinance 1905. It shall be read as one Construction. with the Bakehouses Ordinance 1905 (No. 15—1905), hereinafter called the principal Ordinance. The principal Ordinance and this Ordinance may together be cited as the Bakehouses Ordinances 1905.

2. So much of Section 2 of the principal Ordinance as Repeal. defines the term "Inspector" is hereby repealed, and in lieu thereof shall be read the following:—

"Inspector" means any person appointed by the "Inspector." Governor to be an Inspector or Assistant Inspector under this Ordinance.

3. It shall be lawful for the Governor from time to time Power to to appoint an Inspector and such Assistant Inspectors appoint as inspectors. may be necessary for the proper carrying out of the

provisions of the Bakehouses Ordinances 1905, and it shall also be lawful for the Governor from time to time to revoke any such appointment.

Passed in Council this Fourth day of December, in the year of Our Lord one thousand nine hundred and five.
