AN ORDINANCE to amend the Malicious Injury to Property Ordinance, No. 16.

BE it enacted by the Governor of Trinidad and Tobago with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof as follows:—

- 1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Malicious Injury Short title. to Property Ordinance 1908. It shall be read as one with the Ordinance No. 16.
- 2. Whosoever shall unlawfully and maliciously commit Malicious any damage, injury or spoil to or upon any real or personal injury to property whatsoever, either of a public or private nature, an amount for which no punishment is hereinbefore provided, the damage, injury or spoil being to an amount exceeding five pounds, shall be guilty of a misdemeanour, and being

convicted thereof shall be liable, at the discretion of the Court, to be imprisoned for any term not exceeding two years, with or without hard labour.
