AN ORDINANCE to amend the Criminal Procedure Ordinance, No. 13.

BE it enacted by the Governor of Trinidad and Tobago with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof as follows:—

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Criminal Procedure Ordinance 1908. It shall be read as one with the Criminal Procedure Ordinance (No. 13) and with Ordinance No. 25-1907. Short title.

2. Section 83 of the Criminal Procedure Ordinance (No. 13) is hereby repealed, and in lieu thereof shall be read the following:— Repeal.

83. The Court is hereby authorized, in its discretion, at the request of any person who appears before such Court on recognizance or subpoena to give evidence on behalf of an accused person, to order payment to such witness of such sum of money Expenses of witnesses for the accused.

as to the Court seems reasonable and sufficient to compensate him for the expenses, trouble and loss of time which he incurred or sustained in attending before the examining Magistrate and the Court.
