AN ORDINANCE to repeal certain enactments.

**B**E it enacted by the Governor of Trinidad and Tobago with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof as follows:—

1. The enactments mentioned in the Schedule hereto are hereby repealed to the extent specified in the third column of the said Schedule. Repeal of enactments in Schedule.

2. The repeals enacted by this Ordinance shall not affect the validity or invalidity of anything done or suffered or any right accrued or liability incurred before the commencement of this Ordinance. Saving clause.

No. 178 ...	The Customs Ordinance ...	So much of Section 9 as follows the words "the King's warehouses" in the 18th line thereof.
No. 204 ...	The Land Charges and Land Taxes Ordinance	In Section 2 the following words : " (3) Any annual rate assessed under the Port-of-Spain Waterworks Ordinance. (4) Any rate payable under the Sewerage Ordinance." The first paragraph and the word "other" in the second paragraph of Section 3.
