AN ORDINANCE to amend the Interpretation Ordinance, No. 137.

BE it enacted by the Governor of Trinidad and Tobago with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof as follows:—

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Interpretation Short title. Ordinance 1908.

2. In all Ordinances, and in all legal documents, whether passed or made before or after the commencement of this Ordinance, expressions referring to writing shall, unless the contrary intention appears, be construed as including references to printing, lithography, typewriting, photography, and other modes of representing or reproducing words in a visible form. Expressions referring to writing.
