AN ORDINANCE to amend the Yaws Ordinance No. 191.

BE it enacted by the Governor of Trinidad and Tobago with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof as follows:—

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Yaws Ordinance Short title. 1909. It shall be read as one with the Yaws Ordinance Construction. No. 191 and the Yaws Ordinance 1906 (8—1906).

2. Section 4 of the Yaws Ordinance No. 191 is hereby Repeal. repealed and in lieu thereof shall be read the following:—

4. It shall be lawful for any member of the Medical Board, upon the report in writing of any officer appointed to search as aforesaid that such officer has reasonable cause to suspect that any person is suffering from yaws, to order such person to attend for treatment at a dispensary or to go to or be taken to any hospital or ward of any hospital established under this Ordinance. Power to order to hospital or dispensary.
