AN ORDINANCE to suspend the coming into operation of certain Ordinances.

BE it enacted by the Governor of Trinidad and Tobago with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof as follows :—

Commence-
ment of
Ordinance.

1. "The Property Devolution Ordinance, 1900," "The Wills and Probate Ordinance, 1900" and "The Distributions Ordinance, 1900," shall come into force and be deemed to commence on such day ~~as~~ as the Governor may by Proclamation appoint. ~~7/7/1902.~~

Repeal.

2. The following portions of the said Ordinances are hereby repealed :

In Section 1 of "The Property Devolution Ordinance, 1900," the words "and shall come into operation on the 1st day of July, 1901."

In Section 1 of "The Wills and Probate Ordinance, "1900," the words "and shall come into operation on the first day of July, 1901. Provided "however that."

In Section 1 of "The Distributions Ordinance, "1900," the words "and shall come into operation together with the same on the first day "of July, 1901."

Passed in Council this Seventeenth day of March, in the year of Our Lord one thousand nine hundred and two.
