AN ORDINANCE to amend the Beer Duties Ordinances
1899 and 1901.—(17-1899 and 14-1901.)

BE it enacted by the Governor of Trinidad and Tobago with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof as follows :—

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Beer Duties Short title.
Ordinance 1903.

2. The proviso to Section 9 of the Beer Duties Ordinance Amendment.
1899 shall be read as follows :—

Provided that the time for payment shall not be later than the fifteenth day of the third month succeeding the month in which the duty was charged.
