AN ORDINANCE to make provision for defraying the Expenses of the Government of the Colony of Trinidad and Tobago for the year from 1st April 1903, to 31st March 1904.

BE it enacted by the Governor of Trinidad and Tobago with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof as follows:—

1. There may be issued and paid from and out of the Public Moneys of the Colony of Trinidad and Tobago for the service of the year from 1st April 1903, to 31st March 1904, an amount not exceeding the following sums, that is to say:

the Colony of Trinidad and Tobago upon the Warrant of the Governor, and shall be respectively applied to the Services hereinbefore in that behalf specified.

3. All sums issued and paid out of the said public moneys between the 31st day of March last and the commencement of this Ordinance are hereby declared to have been legally issued and paid, in the same manner and to the same extent as if such payments had been made subsequent to the passing of this Ordinance.
