AN ORDINANCE relating to the giving of credit to members of the Police Force.

BE it enacted by the Governor of Trinidad and Tobago with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof as follows :—

Short title.
Commence-
ment.

1. This Ordinance may be cited as "The Police Ordinance 1902," and shall come into operation on the 1st day of January, 1903.

Certain debts
not recover-
able.

2. No action shall be brought in any Court against any person being a Non-commissioned Officer or Constable of Police within the meaning of "The Police Ordinance 1885" (No. 24-1885) in respect of any money borrowed by him or of any goods taken by or supplied to him or any member of his family on his behalf on credit after the commencement of this Ordinance.

Passed in Council this seventh day of July in the year of Our Lord one thousand nine hundred and two.
