AN ORDINANCE to amend the Bankruptcy Ordinance,
Ch. 6. No. 6.

[22nd November, 1945.]

ENACTED by the Governor of Trinidad and Tobago with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof.

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Bankruptcy (Amendment) Ordinance, 1945, and shall be read as one with the Bankruptcy Ordinance.

Enactment.

2. Section 117 of the Bankruptcy Ordinance is hereby amended—

(a) in subsection (1) by substituting for the words “The Chief Justice, with the concurrence of a Puisne Judge, may make rules” the words “Rules may be made in like manner as rules may be made under and for the purposes of the Judicature Ordinance”;

(b) by deleting subsection (3).

Saving of
existing rules.

3. All rules of court made under the Bankruptcy Ordinance and in force at the commencement of this Ordinance shall remain in force as though this Ordinance had been in force when they were made and they had been made under the provisions of that Ordinance as amended by this Ordinance.
