AN ORDINANCE to amend the Law relating to  
Sewerage rates.

**B**E it enacted by the Governor of Trinidad and Tobago with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof as follows:—

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Sewerage rates Short Title. Ordinance 1904. It shall be read as one with the Port-of-Construction. Spain Sewerage Ordinance 1901, (23-1901) and the Sewerage rates Ordinance 1902, (17-1902). The said Ordinances and this Ordinance may together be cited as the Sewerage Ordinances 1901-4.

2. Notwithstanding the provisions of the Land Charges Increase of and Land Taxes Ordinance 1893 (28-1893), the Port-of-Spain rate in arrear. Sewerage Ordinance 1901, and the Sewerage Rates Ordinance 1902, any Sewerage rate or any part thereof in arrear, if unpaid at the expiration of three months after the same

shall have become due, shall be increased at the rate of Ten pounds per centum in lieu of twenty-five pounds per centum, but in all other respects the provisions of the said Land Charges and Land Taxes Ordinance shall apply to such Sewerage rate.

This provision shall apply to the Sewerage rate which became due and payable on the First day of July in the year 1903.

Passed in Council this 7th day of March, in the year of Our Lord one thousand nine hundred and four.
