BE it enacted by the Governor of Trinidad and Tobago with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof as follows:—

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Pensions (Amend- Short Title.
ment) Ordinance 1905.

2. It shall be lawful for the Governor in Executive Council from time to time to allow any public officer to Certain officers may come under Pensions Ordinance. come within the provisions of the Pensions Ordinance (No. 175), notwithstanding that such public officer may have failed to comply with the provisions of Sections 14 and 15 of the said Ordinance.
