



by the Government Veterinary Surgeon or by some person approved of by him, and when inoculated to be marked with a distinctive brand to be prescribed by the said Veterinary Surgeon.

(2.) The Government Veterinary Surgeon may by writing under his hand authorize any person to inoculate and brand any animals as aforesaid in the possession or under the charge of any person who makes default in carrying out the provisions of this section.

(3.) The Government Veterinary Surgeon may cancel or revoke the appointment of any person approved or authorized by him to inoculate or brand any animal as aforesaid.

(4.) Any person having in his possession or under his charge any animals as aforesaid who neglects or refuses to inoculate and brand or to assist any person authorized by the Government Veterinary Surgeon to inoculate and brand any such animal, or who hinders or obstructs such last mentioned person, or who brands or causes to be branded any animal as aforesaid with the distinctive brand prescribed by the Government Veterinary Surgeon as aforesaid, without such animal having been previously inoculated as provided by Sub-section (1.) hereof, shall be guilty of an offence under the principal Ordinance.
