AN ORDINANCE to amend the Trinidad Fire Insurance Company, Limited, Ordinance (No. 6—1904).

**B**E it enacted by the Governor of Trinidad and Tobago with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof as follows:—

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Fire Insurance <sup>Short Title.</sup> Ordinance 1905. The Ordinance No. 6—1904, and this Ordinance may together be cited as the Fire Insurance Ordinances 1904-5.

2. Section 4 of Ordinance number 6 of 1904 is hereby <sup>Repeal.</sup> repealed and when the revised edition of Ordinances comes into force Section 4 of number 206 thereof shall be deemed to be hereby repealed and in lieu thereof shall be read the following:—

4. The Company shall have and use a Corporate Seal, <sup>Seal.</sup> which may from time to time be changed. Provided that no such change shall be made

except by resolution of the Directors at a general meeting, such resolution to be published in the *Royal Gazette* as soon after such meeting as possible.

Correction of clerical error.

3. Section 17 of Ordinance number 6 of 1904 is hereby repealed and when the revised edition of Ordinances comes into force Section 17 of number 206 thereof shall be deemed to be hereby repealed and in lieu thereof shall be read the following:—

17. In case a Policy of Insurance is held by a Corporate body, the Chairman of Directors or the President of such Corporate body, and failing them any person specially appointed by such Corporate body, shall be entitled to vote for or on behalf of such Corporate body. Provided that no such Chairman, President or other person shall vote at any meeting unless before such meeting the name of such Chairman, President or other person shall have been notified to the Company as that of the person authorized to vote on behalf of such Corporate body.
