AN ORDINANCE to amend the Government Currency
Notes Ordinance 1903 (16—1903).

BE it enacted by the Governor of Trinidad and Tobago
with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council
thereof as follows:—

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Government ^{Short Title.}
Currency Notes Ordinance 1905.

2. In Section 15 of the Government Currency Notes ^{Repeal.}
Ordinance 1903 the words " after they have been published
in the *Royal Gazette* " are hereby repealed, and when the
revised edition of Ordinances comes into force the same
words in Section 15 of number 244 thereof shall be deemed
to have been hereby repealed.

year of Our Lord one thousand nine hundred and five.
