Waiver of Escheat.

AN ORDINANCE to provide for the waiver of the rights of the Crown to real estate in certain cases.

BE it enacted by the Governor of Trinidad and Tobago with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof as follows :—

1. Notwithstanding the repeal of Section 7 of the Casual Revenue Appropriation Ordinance 1894 (No. 8-1894) effected by the Distributions Ordinance 1900 (No. 8-1902), it shall be lawful for the Governor in Executive Council to exercise all the powers and privileges conferred by the said Section 7 in all cases of persons dying without heirs and intestate in respect of all or any part of their real estate before the first day of January 1903, and the practice and procedure in that behalf provided by the said Section 7 shall apply to such cases.

2. This Ordinance shall operate retrospectively, and shall be deemed to have commenced on the first day of January 1903.

Passed in Council this Fifth day of June, in the year of Our Lord one thousand nine hundred and five.
