AN ORDINANCE to amend the District Waterworks Ordinance (No. 223.)

BE it enacted by the Governor of Trinidad and Tobago with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof as follows :—

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the District Water-works Ordinance 1905. It shall be read as one with the District Waterworks Ordinance (No. 223.)

2. No person or persons except those resident within the district in any tenement or premises duly assessed for water rates may take or use water from the Waterworks.

Any person acting in contravention of the provisions of this section shall be guilty of an offence against this Ordinance, and on summary conviction thereof shall be liable to a penalty not exceeding £5, and in default of payment shall be imprisoned with or without hard labour for any term not exceeding three months.

Passed in Council this First day of May, in the year of Our Lord one thousand nine hundred and five.
