AN ACT to amend the Constitution (Prescribed Matters)  
Act, 1966.

[Assented to 22nd September, 1972]

BE IT ENACTED by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, <sup>Enactment</sup>  
by and with the advice and consent of the Senate and  
House of Representatives of Trinidad and Tobago, and  
by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the Constitution (Prescribed <sup>Short title</sup>  
Matters) (Amendment) Act, 1972.

2. The Constitution (Prescribed Matters) Act, 1966, is amended by substituting for the First Schedule occurring therein the following:—

“FIRST SCHEDULE

(d) Chairman of the Teaching Service Commission ... ..	1,200.00
(e) Deputy Chairman of the Teaching Service Commission ... ..	1,000.00
(f) Member of the Teaching Service Commission other than the Chairman and Deputy Chairman or member who is also a member of the Public Service Commission ... ..	500.00
(g) Member of the Police Service Commission other than the Chairman or a member who is also a member of the Public Service Commission ...	200.00
(h) Chairman of the Elections Commission	1,800.00
(i) Member of the Elections Commission other than the Chairman ...	500.00
(j) Members of the Judicial and Legal Service Commission appointed under paragraph (d) of subsection (2) of section 83 of the Constitution	200.00
(k) Auditor General ... ..	2,500.00.”
