AN ORDINANCE to amend the Petroleum (Excise) Ordinance, Cap. 201.

[15th December, 1930.]

**B**E it enacted by the Governor of Trinidad and Tobago with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof as follows :—

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Petroleum Short title. (Excise) (Amendment) Ordinance, 1930, and shall be read as one with the Petroleum (Excise) Ordinance, Cap. 201, Construction. hereinafter called the Principal Ordinance.

2. Section 3 of the Principal Ordinance, as amended Amendment s. 3 of Cap 201. by Ordinance No. 44 of 1925, is hereby repealed, and in lieu thereof shall be read the following :—

3. There shall, subject to the provisions Duty on petroleum spirit and oil. of section 7 of this Ordinance, be charged, collected, and paid to the Treasurer for the use of His Majesty,

in respect of petroleum spirit manufactured and delivered for consumption within the Colony the sum of eight pence on every imperial gallon, and in respect of petroleum oil manufactured and delivered for consumption within the Colony the sum of six pence on every imperial gallon.

3. This Ordinance shall commence on the fifteenth day of December, 1930.
