AN ACT to amend the Constitution (Prescribed Matters)
Act, 1966.

[Assented to 30th June, 1973]

BE IT ENACTED by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by Enactment
and with the advice and consent of the Senate and House
of Representatives of Trinidad and Tobago, and by the
authority of the same, as follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the Constitution (Prescribed Short title
Matters) (Amendment) Act, 1973.

2. The Constitution (Prescribed Matters) Act, 1966, is amended by substituting for the Second Schedule occurring therein the following:—

Commencement

3. This Act shall be deemed to have come into operation on the 1st day of January, 1971; so however that all appointments, removals, disciplinary control and other acts and things made or done by the Public Service Commission in relation to an office set out in the Second Schedule to the Constitution (Prescribed Matters) Act, 1966, before the passing of this Act shall be deemed to have been validly made or done.
