AN ORDINANCE to amend the Public Library Ordinance,
Cap. 289.

[11th June, 1931.]

BE it enacted by the Governor of Trinidad and Tobago with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof as follows :—

- Short title. 1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Public Library (Amendment) Ordinance, 1931, and shall be read as one with the Public Library Ordinance, Cap. 289, hereinafter called the Principal Ordinance.
- Construction.
- Amendment of s. 5 of Cap. 289. 2. Section 5 of the Principal Ordinance is hereby amended by inserting the words "other than members appointed by the Corporation" after the word

“Committee” in the proviso, and by inserting the following additional proviso :

Provided further that members of the Committee appointed by the Corporation shall, during the term for which they are appointed, be entitled to enjoy all the rights and privileges of annual subscribers to the Library, but without being required to pay any subscription.

Passed in Council this twenty-ninth day of May, in the year of Our Lord one thousand nine hundred and thirty-one.
